



2009 Minimum Performance Criteria WWA World Championships

This document outlines the minimum performance criteria by which athletes qualify to participate at the 2009 WWA Wakeboard World Championships. The WSWC Wakeboard Committee shall have the authority to make all decisions with respect to the criteria.

Introduction

WSWC's overall wakeboard program goal is to develop riders capable of winning medals in the most elite categories at world championships.

Eligibility

All competitive license holders who are Canadian citizens and are members in good standing of Water Ski and Wakeboard Canada (WSWC), and who are deemed eligible by the World Wakeboard Association (WWA) are eligible.

To be eligible to participate at the 2009 WWA World Championship riders must meet at least one of the minimum performance criteria listed below. A list of all riders has been forwarded to the WWA and riders should contact the WWA directly to register.

Anyone not meeting the minimum performance criteria should forward their results from the 2008 and 2009 seasons to WSWC before August 15th, 2009.

Minimum Performance Criteria

Minimum performance is based on the following:

- all riders who competed at the 2008 WWA Wakeboard World Championships;
OR
- riders who finished Top 2 in their division of 2008 Canadian Wakeboard Championships;
OR
- all riders who competed in the Open Final at the 2008 Canadian Wakeboard Championships;
OR
- riders who have competed in a minimum of three sanctioned pro events, as defined in Appendix 1, and have advanced beyond the second round at least once within the 2008 or 2009 season;



Eligible sanctioned pro events
