

## 2012 Selection Criteria World Show Skiing Tournament Team

This document outlines the criteria by which the 2012 World Tournament Show Skiing Canadian team shall be selected. The Show Director (SD) shall have the authority to make all decisions with respect to the criteria.

### Introduction

WSWC's overall show skiing program goal is to support our country's top athletes as they strive to achieve success at our sport's highest level of competition and performance.

### Eligibility

All competitive license holders who are Canadian citizens and are members in good standing of Water Ski and Wakeboard Canada (WSWC), and who are deemed eligible by the International Water Ski Federation, as the case may be, are eligible for selection to the team. In consideration of the expected international travel, all members must also have a valid Canadian passport.

### Selection Term

Subject to the member signing a WSWC Participant Agreement, the term of team selection shall be for approximately one year, from the date of selection to close of the 2012 IWWF World Show Skiing Tournament.

### Selection Process

All those wishing to be considered for selection to the team must submit a written sport resume to the Show Director prior to midnight February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Please indicate role (s) you wish to be considered for. If you have a video of your riding and skills please submit to facilitate the selection process.

The Show Director will contact each team member individually prior to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. The final roster will be publically announced by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012.

### Selection Criteria

Selection to the 2012 World Tournament Show Skiing Canadian team will be determined on the basis previous performances and the review of your sport resume. Aspects to be considered:



- Worked for a minimum of 1 year or season at a amateur or professional ski show site
- Competed in at least 1 discipline specific competition at a national level.
- All athletes must show consistent water ski and wakeboard skills at a high level in competition disciplines and/or show skiing performance.
- Athletes need to be comfortable with role playing real or fictional characters and also speaking publically to large audiences.
- Respect shown on and off the water for other team members' ideas and goals.

### **Selection of Alternates**

The SD may, but is not obligated to name up to four alternates based on the foregoing selection criteria. The alternates may be selected at the time team is selected or may be selected at a later date.

### **Program Outline**

- The entire program is self-funded – no funding will be provided by WSWC
- All skiers, coaches, drivers, members of the team must be WSWC members in good standing and meet the IWWF skier eligibility requirements.
- All team members and support staff must sign a WSWC participant agreement which includes policies related to code of conduct, harassment, anti-doping, appeals and arbitration.
- All team members and support staff must complete an anti-doping online workshop.
- All team members and support staff must purchase and show proof of out of country insurance for the event.
- Individual members may solicit team sponsors, which can not include the tobacco industry of any kind. Sponsorship dollars will be received by WSWC and will 100% be attributed to the program.
- Team members may not bind WSWC to any servicing obligations related to securing sponsorship without prior consent from WSWC and possible related servicing reimbursement (ie advertising, webpage content, etc)
- Any donations received by the team may be eligible for a charitable tax donation receipt. All donations would have to meet the criteria established by Canada Revenue Agency and be collected by WSWC and 100% attributed to the program.

### **Major Benefit to Team Selection**

- Participation at the 2012 World Show Skiing Tournament as a member of Team Canada.
