

Show Director – Canadian Show Ski Team

Role

Under the direction of the Director of Sport, the Show Director will lead and organize a program designed to enhance Canadian level of international excellence at the 2012 World Show Skiing Championships. This is a volunteer position.

Reporting Authority

The Show Director must report to the WSWC Director of Sport. The Show Director shall have the responsibility and authority to manage the program within the parameters of the program designed by WSWC Director of Sport.

Responsibilities

- Develop a proposed Canadian Show Ski Team selection criteria for approval by the Director of Sport, and subsequently communicate and implement the criteria;
- Develop a Canadian Show Ski Team training plan, program outcomes and objectives;
- Coordinate and implement all activities related to the Canadian Show Ski Team program;
- Oversee and manage the Canadian Show Ski Team budget;
- To make sure that the team follows all the rules and regulations set out by WSWC;
- To provide a safe training place with a structure plan and a understanding of is expected from each performer;
- To be responsible for all team members on and off the water;
- To communicate with all team members via, email, phone;
- To provide a final report to WSWC on the overall program outcomes and objectives.

Requirements/Qualifications

- At least five years experience in international professional shows;
- Must have experience in all show skiing disciplines;
- Experience in managing budgets and coordinating event logistics;
- The ability to verbally communicate in both official languages (English and French) would be a definite asset. English is essential;
- Willing to undergo a police screening;
- Excellent communication, organizational and leadership skills;
- Must have first hand experiences with different shows.
