

2010 - 11 WSWC Enriched Funding Program Outline

Goals of WSWC's Enriched Funding

Program

1. To place classic water skiers on the podium at the World Championships, Pan American Games and other notable international competitions.
2. To develop high performing and podium finishing classic water skiers in World Championships and Pan American Games.
3. To support athletes financially towards the above objectives, through Enriched Funding.

Intent of WSWC's Enriched Funding Program

The intent of the WSWC Enriched Funding Program is to supplement the available financial resources of the selected athletes so they can train, travel and compete on a regular basis in accordance with the activities outlined in their yearly training program (YTP).

Athletes Eligible for Funding

To be eligible for enriched funding, the athlete must be a WSWC member in good standing, must meet all Canadian and IWSF eligibility requirements for participation in national and international competition and be named to the Tier 1 National Team (Sport Canada Carded) through the National Team program eligibility criteria.

Secondary Eligibility Parameters

Enriched funding may also be available to athletes falling within the secondary eligibility parameters. Secondary funding, when available, will:

- Be reserved for consideration only to athletes who are:
 - On the National Team but who are not Sport Canada carded
 - On the Canadian Development team
 - The respective athlete is prepared to sign the WSWC Athlete Agreement or fulfill such conditions as the National Team Coach (NTC) may require.
- Be in support of specific training or competitive opportunities as directed by the NTC
- Be in support of a special need or circumstance.

Enriched Funding Allocation

During the term from April 1, 2010 through to March 31, 2011, Enriched Funding shall be allocated as follows:

1. 4200\$CAD to each classic water ski athlete who is carded through Sport Canada's AAP
2. Additional funds may be available for allocation at the sole discretion of the NTC consistent with the above program goals and in keeping with the stated general guidelines.

Claim Procedures

- The program is a reimbursement program for approved expenses.
- Expense claim forms must be completed with original receipts.
- In order to be reimbursed athletes must submit to WSWC **original receipts** as proof of purchase. Photocopies or any other facsimile **will not be accepted**.
- Proof of payment (original receipts) must be dated no later than March 31, 2011. Original receipts must be submitted to the WSWC office by April 30, 2011. **No exceptions**.
- Receipts must be dated between April 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011.
- Distribution of funds will be based on the following breakdown:
 - i. 60% of expenses (\$2520CAD) towards competition expenses, as approved by the NTC as essential within the athlete's Yearly Training Plan.
 - ii. 40% of expenses (\$1680CAD) towards training expenses, as approved by the NTC as essential within the athlete's Yearly Training Plan.
- Training expenses include:
 - Boat rentals and gas fees
 - Coaching/training set expenses.
 - Travel to and from training and training camps, including excess baggage fees.
 - Accommodation and per diem meals during training and training camps.
- Competition expenses include:
 - Travel to and from competitions, including excess baggage fees.
 - Accommodation and per diem meals during competitions.
 - Entry fees to competitions.
